What is Cub Scout Day Camp?

It is a great opportunity for your child to enjoy 3 fun-filled days with his/her fellow Scouts at one of our nearby camps!

What will my son do at Day Camp?

Our Scouts will enjoy some of their favorite outdoor activities such as; B-B gun shooting, archery shooting, learn about nature, play games, sing songs, perform skits, and more! Some of our camps even include fishing!

Do parents need to attend?

We have a wonderful Day Camp staff that works great with kids, but it is important to your child that we have adequate adult leadership with each Pack/Group. Make sure and discuss the leadership details with your Cubmaster when you sign up your child. **Each Pack or Group should provide one "walking-leader" for every five youth that are attending with a minimum of two adults.** The "walking-leader" is a volunteer who spends his/her day with the group. I would encourage each parent to spend a day or more with your child to share the lifelong memories that will be made!

Cub Scout Activity Award

Attending Cub Scout Day Camp is one of the requirements to earn the Cub Scout Outdoor Activity Award. It should be the goal of each Pack to achieve this award together and have some fun earning it!

OTHER HELPFUL INFORMATION: Parents are welcome to bring their other children along, but if they are not registered with the Boy Scouts of America they cannot participate in the events. Day care facilities will not be offered for the other children. This is an opportunity to spend quality time with your child.

Also, each youth should register with his Pack/Group. Please talk with your Cubmaster to sign him/her up with the other children from his/her own Pack/Group. If your child is the only youth attending from his/her Pack/Group, please don't hesitate to sign him/her up, he/she will still have a blast and make some new friends!
