What is Cub Scout Day Camp?

It is a great opportunity for your son to enjoy 3 fun-filled days with his fellow Scouts at one of our nearby camps!

What will my son do at Day Camp?

Our Scouts will enjoy some of their favorite outdoor activities such as; B-B gun shooting, archery shooting, fishing, learn about nature, play games, sing songs, perform skits, and more!

Do parents need to attend?

We have a wonderful Day Camp staff that works great with kids, but it is important to your son that we have adequate adult leadership with each Pack/Den. Make sure and discuss the leadership details with your Cubmaster when you sign up your son. **Each Pack or Den should provide one “walking-leader” for every five youth that are attending, with a minimum of two adults.** The “walking-leader” is a volunteer who spends his/her day with the group. Remember that Tiger adult partners must attend with their Tiger Cub. I would encourage each parent to spend a day or more with your son to share the lifelong memories that will be made!

Cub Scout Activity Award

Attending Cub Scout Day Camp is one of the requirements to earn the Cub Scout Outdoor Activity Award. It should be the goal of each Pack to achieve this award together and have some fun earning it!

FEES: Each camp will cost \$43.00 or just \$40.00 if registered with and paid with the Pack by May 1st. The fee includes 3 fun-filled days, a Cub Scout Day Camp theme T-shirt, a Scout Drinking cup, a craft to bring home each day, and other fun materials!

WHAT TO BRING: Appropriate clothing (dress for weather), comfortable shoes (not open toed), sunscreen, hat, backpack, sack lunch with drink, and money for trading post.

CAN MY SON ATTEND MORE THAN ONE CAMP? Yes, the fee remains the same for the first camp (\$40.00) and any additional camps are reduced to \$33.00 each. Each camp will have similar activities, but there will be opportunities to experience different events, make new friends, and have more fun if your son attends more than one camp! Also, please note that your youth will only receive a T-shirt and cup at the first camp they attend.

OTHER HELPFUL INFORMATION: Parents are welcome to bring their other children along, but if they are not registered with the Boy Scouts of America they cannot participate in the events. Day care facilities will not be offered for the other children. This is an opportunity to spend quality time with your son.

Also, each youth should register with his Pack. Please talk with your Cubmaster to sign him up with the other boys from his own Pack/Den. If your son is the only youth attending from his Pack, please don't hesitate to sign him up, he will still have a blast and make some new friends!
